

Fish Market. Fish Auction.



INTRODUCTION.



There are two parallel auction lines: one is fitted with a white **CLINA 12CK**, (**photo 1**), and the other with a blue **NOVAK 19CK**, in order to distinguish between them.

ARRIVAL OF THE FISH AT THE AUCTION. LOADING THE FIRST BELT.



The trawler arrives in the port and the boxes of fish are unloaded by hand. These are then conveyed on trolleys to the auction entrance (**photos 3 and 4**). The first belts are then loaded: 2 parallel lines, one **CLINA 12CK**, and one **NOVAK 19CK**, both 690 mm x 6,150 m (**photo 5**).

THE SCALES. ENTERING THE EACH BOX'S WEIGHT AND TYPE OF FISH INTO THE COMPUTER.



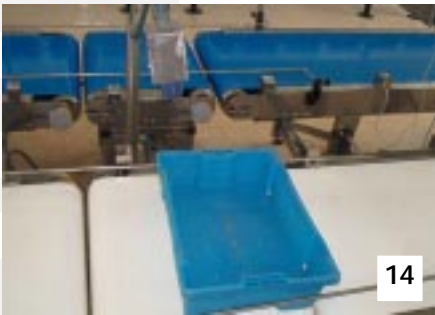
The boxes of fish are moved onto the next, smaller conveyer, fitted with a **CLINA 12CK** and a **NOVAK 19CK**, both 700 mm x 1,750 m. Scales are used to weigh the fish, this data is then entered into the computer (weight, type of fish, fisherman's name), and the corresponding label is dropped into each box (photos 6, 7, 8, 9, 10).

ACCUMULATION OF BOXES FOR BUYERS TO VIEW.



Once weighed and labelled, the boxes are moved onto 2 conveyers fitted with a **CLINA 12CK** (690 mm x 10,150 m and 690 mm x 14,150 m) and a **NOVAK 19CK** with the same measurements on the other parallel line. During this part of the process, buyers take a general look at the boxes, before moving on to the auction itself (photos 11, 12, and 13).

After passing through the accumulation and general viewing lines, the boxes of fish move onto a small conveyor (photos 14 and 15) which are fitted with a **CLINA 12CK**, 700 mm x 1,350 and a **NOVAK 19CK** of the same measurements in the other parallel line. Here, each box stops while the webcam focuses on it (photo 16). At this point, the buyers can see what is being auctioned on each line on a screen (photo 17).

BUYER LABELLING POINT.



Using a remote control, the buyers decide on the price they are interested in and purchase the product. The belt then starts up and the box moves onto the next conveyor, fitted with a **CLINA 12CK**, and a **NOVAK 19CK** on the other line, each one measuring 690 mm x 23,150 m. On this section, the buyer label, with all the buyer's details, is dropped into each box (photos 18, 19, 20).



UNLOADING AND REMOVING THE BOXES FROM THE AUCTION.



The two parallel lines unload the boxes, which are stored in an adjoining room, where the buyers go to collect them after paying (photos 21, 22, 23). The auction is now at an end.



Belts for Fish Auctions

CLINA 12CK (2 -ply)

- PVC Belt, white, FDA food quality
 - Rigid weft
 - Excellent resistance to moisture
- Resistance to vegetable oils and fats and limited resistance to animal fats
- K pattern on the bottom cover, which protects the lower fabric and enables the belt to slide on a stainless steel bed.



NOVAK 19CK (2-ply)

- PVC Belt, blue, FDA food quality
 - Flexible weft
 - Excellent resistance to moisture
- Resistance to vegetable oils and fats and limited resistance to animal fats
- K pattern on the bottom cover, which protects the lower fabric and enables the belt to slide on a stainless steel bed.
